PLACES OF HOLDING COURT

IT IS ORDERED:

The purpose of this order is to designate an off-site place in the county where sessions of district court may be held for specific cases.

1. The 55th District Court is authorized to hold a session of court on Friday, December 2, 2016 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. at Haslett High School, located at 5450 Marsh Road Haslett, MI.
2. The cases heard in court will be predetermined.
3. Litigants may decline to participate and may request that their cases be heard in the courthouse proper at another time.
4. The off-site session will be open to the public.
5. The plan for this off-site session takes into account factors regarding:
 - a. security
 - b. approved recording of proceedings
 - c. notification to parties/witnesses/public
 - d. adequate sound systems
 - e. site decorum, furniture, and audience preparation
 - f. transportation of court files and records
 - g. post hearing transactions such as payments and clearances
 - h. home court coverage.
