- The Sobriety Court participation fee of \$1,000 is authorized by MCL 600.1070(4) and reasonably related to the cost to the court for administering the program.
- Program length and some terms are determined by charge type:
  - Felony participants are ordered to serve 36 months in program, and must complete 180 hours Community Service Work.
  - Misdemeanor participants are ordered to serve 24 months in program and must complete 120 hours Community Service Work.
- Each phase is a minimum of 12 weeks, and phase transitions occur at the discretion of the Sobriety Court judge.
- Upon completion of Phase IV, participants must remain in compliance with all terms until the next graduation and document sobriety for the 90 consecutive days immediately preceding graduation.
