2016 FELONY REPRESENTATION IN THE DISTRICT COURT

The purpose of this order is to provide first appearance legal representation to eligible defendants charged with felony cases in the district court.


IT IS ORDERED:

Eligible Defendants facing felony charges in the jurisdiction of the 55th District Court shall be represented counsel appointed by the District Court. This appearance will be limited to arraignment only and shall terminate when the arraiging magistrate or judge enters an order relating to bond. Notification of Defendants' need for court appointed counsel through the 30th Circuit Court's pretrial services division will continue to be made utilizing the procedures in place.

This order is effective for the calendar year (county fiscal year) 2016.


